

Edward R. Simms March 14, 1837 – March 17, 1922

Enlisted on April 8, 1861, Co. D, SC 2^{nd} Regiment (Sumter Volunteers) – Transferred to Co. K between July, 1861 and January, 1862

Reenlisted on January 28, 1862 into Capt. A.B. Rhett's Co (became Capt. Ficklings Co. Brooks Light Artillery)

Discharged on April 9, 1865 at Appomattox Court House.

Highest Rank: Corporal

Wounded four times: Back injuries / Deaf in one ear from shell explosion
